The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Sustainable Rural Water Supply and Sanitation (SRWS) Program and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include Strategic Program Support to Ministry of Water and Irrigation (MoWI) in the implementation of the Sustainable Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Program (SRWS) which also seek to support the establishment of a rural water agency. The SRWS Program will be implemented over a period of six (6) years. The **Strategic Program Support Consultant (SPSC)** is a **three-year engagement** to support the initial rollout of the Sustainable Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Program, deploying about **790 professionalstaff-months** during thisperiod.The assignment is expected to start in March 2019.

The Ministry of Water and Irrigation now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are as follows:

- (i) Core business of the firm and years in business.

- (ii) Experience of similar assignment in the field of rural water supply and sanitation including community lead total sanitation approach.
- (iii) Experience of having worked in sub-Saharan Africa or similar environment.
- (iv) The technical and managerial capability of the firm. (Provide only the structure of the organization, general qualifications and number of key staff. Do not provide CV of staff. Key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.)

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to section III, paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 revised November 2017 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualification but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Quality and Cost Based Selection** method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
