1. This request for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice for the project that appeared in the United Nations Development Business; Issue No. WB5803 – 12/16 of December 21, 2016.
2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania through the Ministry of Water (MoW) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Water Sector Support Project (WSSP II) which is part of the Second Water Sector Development Program (WSDP II) and intended to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
3. The Individual consulting services (“the services”) include Consultancy Services for Modernizing Hydrological and Meteorological Monitoring System including to provide comprehensive support to DWR staff towards preparation of the technical and functional specifications for modernization of water resources monitoring network and operations, improvement of weather and extreme weather forecasting and supporting the Ministry to oversee the supply and installation of equipment to assure that the equipment and installation meets the technical and functional requirements as specified and contracted.

4. The Ministry of Water (MoW) now invites eligible Individual consultants to express their interest in providing the above-mentioned services. The short-listing criteria shall include but not limited to i) At least ten (10) years of total experience on hydrology, meteorology or water resources management and minimum of five (5) years proven experience in design and installation of hydro-meteorological monitoring. ii) Must have prior experience in designing hydromet networks of at least five (5) years using a wide range of measurement and telemetry approaches. Specific experience with Meteosat/GOES DCS is also desired iii) Experience in installing hydrometeorological networks using a wide range of sensors and Meteosat/GOES DCS, is also desirable.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
