PROVISION OF CONSULTANCY SERVICE TO SURVEY HOTSPOTS WITH RISKS TO WATER RESOURCES AND PREPARE RISK-REDUCTION ACTION PLANS, IN THE USANGU CATCHMENT.

1. This request for Expression of Interest follows the General Procurement Notice for the World Bank under Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism, Resilient Natural Resources Management for Tourism and growth project (REGROW) No 15052, which appeared in PPRA Portal on 17.08.2018.
2. The Government of Tanzania (GoT) under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism, with support from the World Bank, is implementing the Resilient Natural Resource Management for Tourism and Growth Project (REGROW). The aim of REGROW is to strengthen the management and development of priority tourism assets, and promote sustainability of natural resources in Southern Tanzania. Objectives of the project is to strengthen catchment conservation activities in selected Sub-Basins upstream RUNAPA, to reduce the number of dry days in the river and ensure long term sustainability of RUNAPA's wildlife and the tourism that comes associated with it.
3. The Rufiji Basin Water Board now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the above service. Interest consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, the name and contacts addresses of client served, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).
