1. This request for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice for the project that appeared in the United Nations Development Business; Issue No. WB5803 – 12/16 of December 21, 2016.

The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania through the Ministry of Water (MoW) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Water Sector Support Project (WSSP II) which is part of the Second Water Sector Development Program (WSDP II) and intended to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
3. The Individual service (“the services”) includes Technical Advisor for Supporting Implementation of Integrated Water Resources Management and Development (IWRMD) at National and Basin Levels. The main objective of the assignment is providing strategic level support to the Water Resources Division, National Water Board and Basin Water Boards to advance the implementation of the completed Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Plans.
4. The Ministry of Water (MoW) now invites eligible individual consultants to express their interest in providing the above mentioned services. The evaluation criteria shall include but not limited to (i) an International IWRM expert with at least 10 years of experience in IWRM at national and Basin levels. Professional experience in

Tanzania's Water sector with a strong bias in Water Sector Development Programme would be an added advantage, ii) MSc degree or equivalent in Water Resources planning, Water resources management, Water resources engineering or related field of natural sciences, (iii) Proven track record of preparing Terms of Reference and other tender documents related to Water resources management in accordance with World Bank Guidelines, iv) Ability to function as an active member of a dynamic team of professionals in the Water sector, self-motivated, and able to work independently, (v) Excellent communication and report writing skills, and (vi) Be able to travel extensively in the field in implementation of assigned duties.
